Chantho is one of a number of children who had been sponsored in their first year with Sustainable Cambodia, in 2008, through a special grant from the Rotary Club of Locust Valley, NY, USA. The grant helped to enroll children who were from particularly economically challenged families, and helped the families to obtain farming and vocational assistance. Note to Sponsors: In addition to students in grades 1-12 in the SC school, SC has numerous preschools and nearly 60 students who are attending university in Cambodia on scholarship. The SC grade school is a supplement to the Government school, not a replacement. In developing countries, including Cambodia, it sometimes takes students several more years to complete secondary school, so it is not unusual for a student 18 or 19 years old to be in grade 12. The important thing is that they stay in school. Last school year, more than 90% of our grade 12 graduates qualified for and received university scholarship! That is what sponsorship can make happen!
