~~ Female 12 years old - Birthdate: 02/20/1998 ~~ Bopha, like all the children in Sustainable Cambodia's school, is from the rural villages in Pursat, in central Cambodia. Without the SC program, most of these children would attend a few years of government school, and then would drop out before completion. Without the wells and water that SC sponsorship provides, the children often must spend several hours a day carrying water from distant locations. With SC sponsorship, families participate in community development programs that help create an environment in which the children can thrive. And the SC school provides books, clothes, school supplies, bicycles and multiple enrichment classes. Children and families learn that, with hard work, they can succeed. Your sponsorship will keep the dream alive.

Note to Sponsors: In addition to students in grades 1-12 in the SC school, SC has numerous preschools and nearly 60 students who are attending university in Cambodia on scholarship. The SC grade school is a supplement to the Government school, not a replacement. In developing countries, including Cambodia, it sometimes takes students several more years to complete secondary school, so it is not unusual for a student 18 or 19 years old to be in grade 12. The important thing is that they stay in school. Last school year, more than 90% of our grade 12 graduates qualified for and received university scholarship! That is what sponsorship can make happen!
